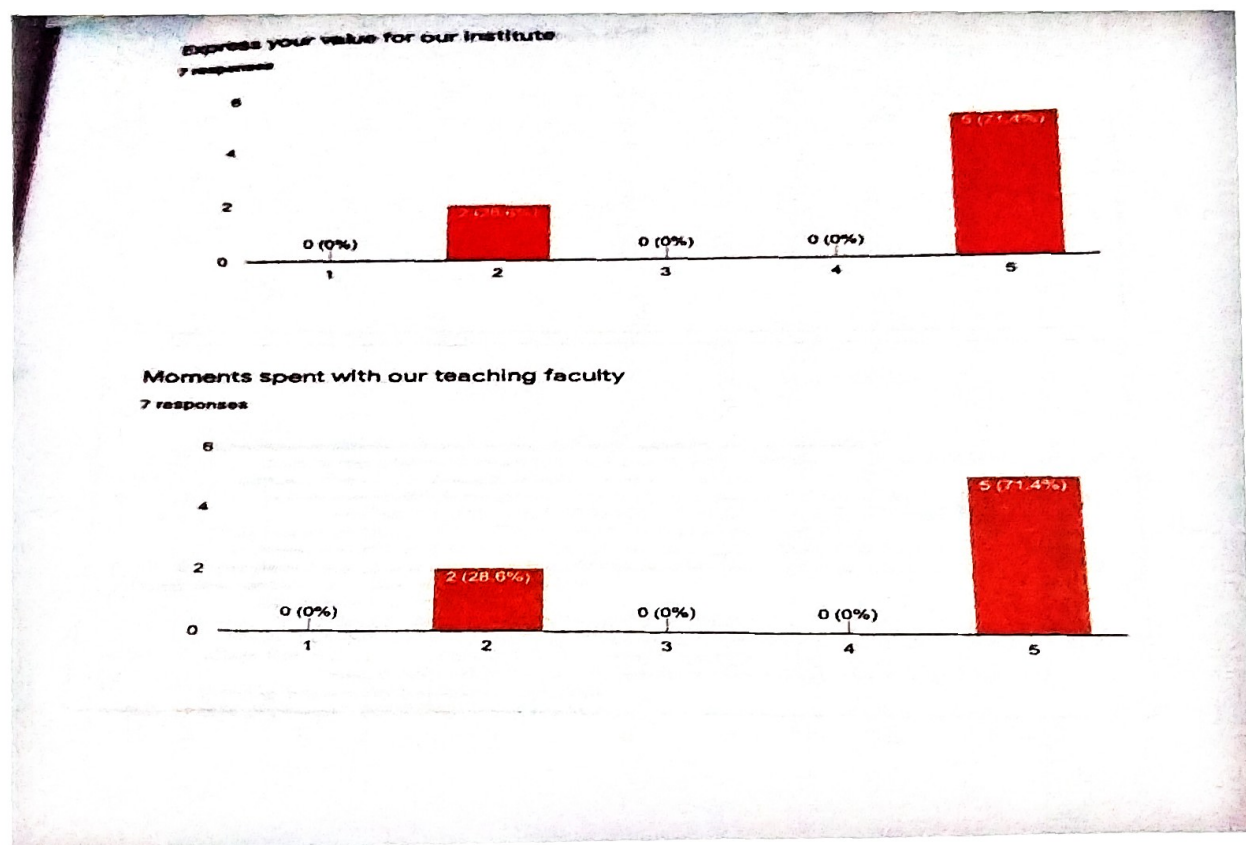
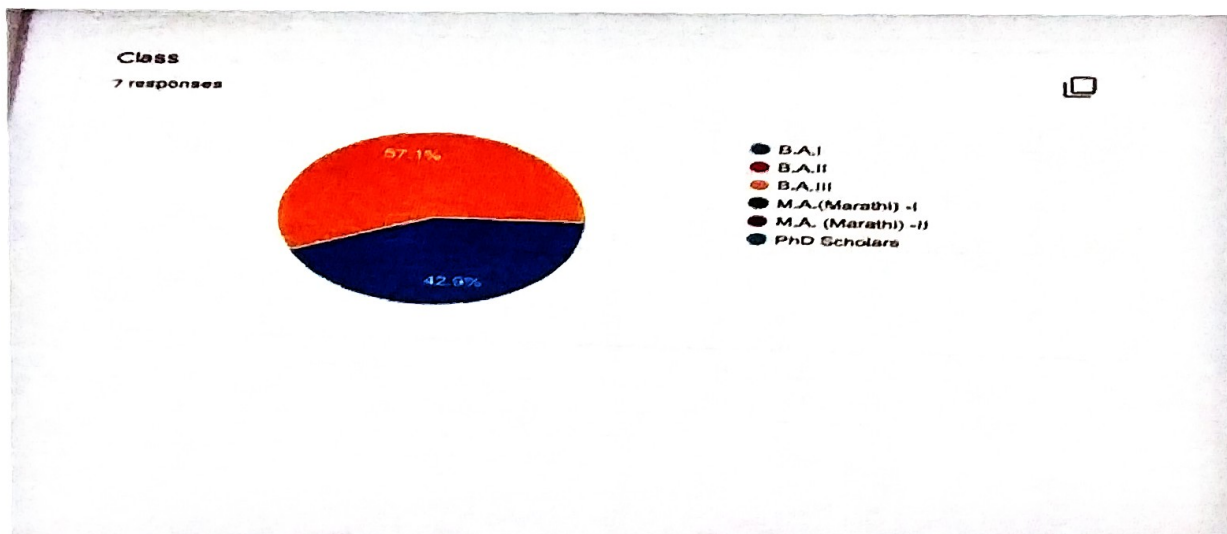

Feedback Analysis Report 2020-21

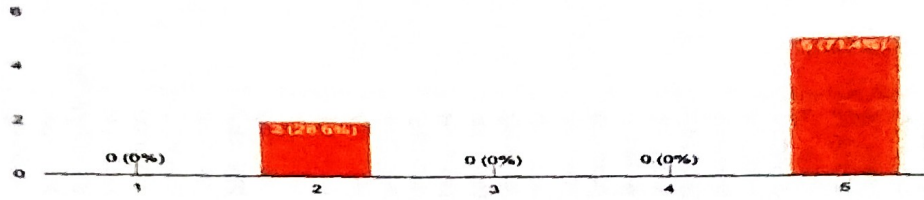
1. The continuous analysis of the teaching and learning process with the help of students' and parents' feedback to improve the knowledge, skills and the quality of the education.

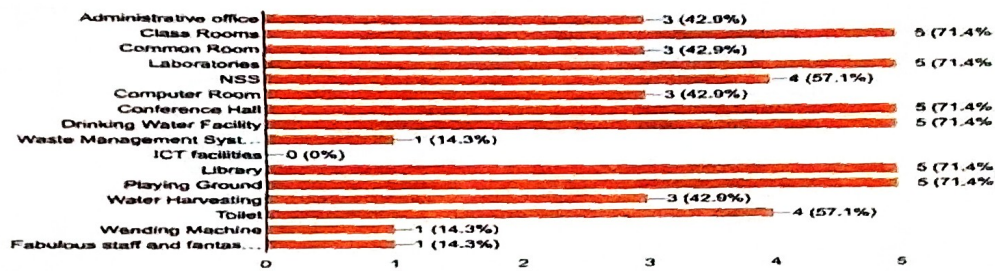

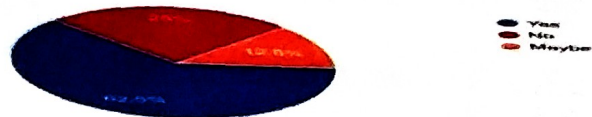

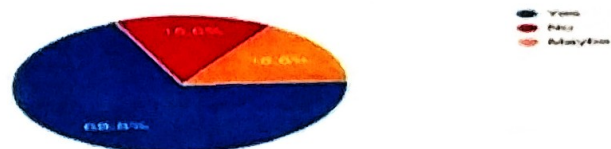

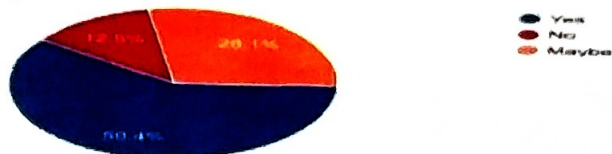

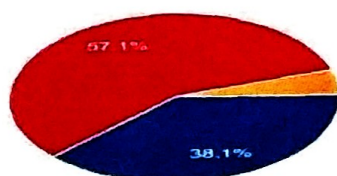
