The Unnat Bharat Abhiyan is inspired by the vision of transformational change in the rural development process by knowledge institutions to help to shape the structure of an inclusive India. Unnat Bharat Abhiyan aims to engage higher education institutions with the people of rural India to identify development challenges. It is to enable the development of appropriate solutions to accelerate sustainable development. It also aims to create a virtuous circle between society and the inclusive education system by providing knowledge and practices for emerging businesses and improving the capabilities of both the public and private sectors to respond to the development needs.

The Unnat Bharat Abhiyan is the scheme of the Government of India. The features of the Unnat Bharat Abhiyan is to develop the rural areas of India. This was implemented by Shriram Education Society Dhamangaon Rly's institute Shriram Kala Mahila Mahavidyalaya, Dhamangaon Rly. Unnat Bharat Department was established in the college in the academic year 2020-21. After the establishment of it the Principal of Shriram Kala Mahila Dhamangaon Rly appointed Prof. Abhijit Doad as Unnat Bharat Mission Mahavidyalaya Coordinator. As per the above objectives of Unnat Bharat it focuses on a preliminary study of the various problems in the rural areas of the college. The following five villages were selected which were KashiKhed, Tivara, Wadhona, Dhanodi and Supalwada respectively. Principal of the college Dr. Nandkishore U. Raut , Professor Abhijit Dod, Professor Nitin Bihade and students of the college surveyed the villages in the area of Dhamangaon Rly taluka at the Wadhona. The survey was conducted on 02nd and 03rd February 2023, in the presence of Sarpanch Shri Prashant Hude along with the village sevak Mr. Vilas Bire and Rozgar Sevak Mr. Nilesh Gudde and Gram Panchayat members.

On the occasion, the members of Gurudev Seva Mandal and villagers were also interacted with students. After holding a meeting with the villagers, they were informed about the importance of Unnat Bharat Abhiyaan and the cooperation of the villagers in Unnat Bharat Abhiyaan. After that, the students of B.A. Part I, II and III of the college went to every house and conducted a household survey. A total of 122 houses were surveyed.

The students asked to the head of the family about gender, age, contact number, identity card, house number, poverty status, type of house, waste management system as compost pit, biogas plant, total income, name of household members, age, gender, marital Information educationals. Aadhaar status, education. regarding card, education, pension, employment guarantee scheme and occupations. Along with this, if the family members have migrated, their information is also given by the people. The students also collected the information about Pradhan Mantri Jan Dhan Yojana, Pradhan Mantri, Ujwala Yojana Pradhan Mantri, Awas Yojana, Sukanya Samriddhi Yojana, Mudra Yojana, Suraksha Bima Yojana, Atal Pension Yojana, Crop Bima Yojana, Skill Development Yojana. The students collected the information about agricultures irrigation, public medicine, Ladli Lakshmi Yojana, Janani Suraksha Yojana, Kisan Credit Card Yojana and drinking water facilities. They asked, information regarding household energy, how much agricultural land each family has? How much irrigated area? What crops are grown in each farm and its average yield? How much chemical fertilizers and pesticides are used in the farm? The number of livestock owned by each family, including the number of different domestic animals. A similar survey was conducted on 08th and 09th February, 2023 at the village Kasikhed. On the occasion, Principal Dr. Nandkishore Raut of Shriram Kala Mahila Mahavidyalaya Dhamangaon Rly Unnat Bharat Abhiyan's Coordinator Prof. Abhijit Dod, Assist. Prof. Nitin Bihade and students of the college. They conducted Unnat Bharat Survey of 169 houses in the village Kashikhed. Sarpanch of that village in Kasikhed Mrs. Shardatai Thackeray as well as Gram Sevak Mr. Chavan Saheb and Rozgar Sevak Kapil Nijte were also present at this time.
